Installing and Running Demos

Demo descriptions, installation instructions, and MPEG movie clips depicting each demo can be accessed directly from the Demos CD-ROMs. Demos must be installed on your system's hard drive to run.

Accessing Installation Instructions/Descriptions/Movie Clips

- 1. Insert the corresponding General and O2 Demos CD-ROM, or the Octane and Octane2 Demos CD-ROM in the drive.
- 2. Double-click the CD-ROM icon.
- Double-click on the Web jumper icon available labelled O2_Demos_CD_Start_Here or Octane_Demos_CD_Start_Here.

Note: General Demos and Octane2 Demos do not have an associated Start_Here document. The Installation instructions below apply to all demo sets included in the CDs.

Installing Demos on Your System

- 1. Insert the CD-ROM.
- 2. From the Toolchest, choose System > Software Manager.
- 3. Type /CDROM/install in the Available Software field and click the *Lookup* button.
- 4. Click *Customize Installation* to select from a list of installable demos. Or click *Default Installation* to install a subset of available demos.

Running Demos from the Web-based Demo Interface

- 1. From the Toolchest, choose Find > Demos.
- 2. Netscape Navigator opens with the Web-based demo interface.
- 3. In the left-hand frame of Netscape, under Show, choose All Demos, IRIX Demos, O2 Demos, or Octane Demos to list all demos, General Demos, O2- or Octane-specific demos respectively.

Alternatively, if you are logged in as the user Demos, you can use the Web jumper on the desktop labelled StartDemos. Double-click this icon to start the Web interface.

Note: The Web interface will not support Octane2 Demos until later IRIX releases. To run Octane2 demos, use the buttonfly or command-line interface.
