Thank you for purchasing the Silicon Graphics[®] Onyx4[™] UltimateVision[™] system. As part of your Onyx4 system, you now have the ability to synchronize the graphics pipelines using the enclosed ImageSynchronization Card [ISI].

The ISI Card allows you to internally synchronize two or more Onyx4 graphics pipelines at various rates for synchronized viewing on multiple displays, such as a PowerWall[™] or CAVE[®]. When running a system with the ISI, the first Xserver gains possession of the ISI. It is recommended that you only use one Xserver with an ISI installed; multiple Xservers may create contentions and introduce instability.

The ISI card is typically located in Bus 2 Slot 1 of the host system. However, the ISI card can be installed in any open PCI slot location. The cable that connects the host system ISI to the G2-brick is SGI Part Number 018-1126-003 and was included in the original system shipment. For installation and cabling instructions, please refer to Chapter 7 of the User's Guide provided with your Onyx4 UltimateVision system.

The minimum software for the ISI card include the following:
