About the External SCSI Device

Before connecting this device to your workstation, you must set its SCSI address. Follow the instructions on installing peripherals in your workstation's Owner's Guide to determine what SCSI address to assign and how to connect the device. Refer also to the appropriate section for your workstation below.

To locate the SCSI address push-button switch or dial, look on the rear or bottom of the device. Use a pencil tip or small screwdriver to set the dial or to push the buttons on the switch.

For the second and all other devices on a daisy chain, use a Centronics 50-pin to Centronics 50-pin half-meter cable. Attach the Centronics active terminator shipped with this device to the *last* SCSI device on the daisy-chain.
